What we are planning to include in the program . . .



How Many Hours and how long will it take to complete the course?

Students will attend 90 hours of 8 classroom modules at the centrally located Fayette County Area Vocational-Technical School. Classes cover safety, construction math, hand tools, power tools,

blueprints, rigging, communication and employability.

There is another 240 hours of hands on experience building habitat homes. This experience can start with groundbreaking and take individuals through everything it takes to complete the construction of a Habitat Home.

There is an additional 30 hours of required community service projects that will need to be completed before a student will receive their Accreditation. These community services projects will be used to help the elderly and low income residents of our county with home repairs, or other needs that can give our students diversified construction training in this pre-apprenticeship program. This is an overall Habitat learning experience that will provide students with a Habitat Certificate for Completing 10 weeks (360 hours) of Basic Building Trade Skills Training and Community Service. Many doors will be opened for opportunities to take these skills on to a career in the construction industry.



Does this type of Career Interest you?

Most high school graduates moving on to college are seeking careers in Technical jobs dealing with computers, communications, and other related fields.

We have met with the local Builder's Association and Contractors to identify their needs.

The contractors can not find qualified workers. If they need a crew of six, they hire twelve, because half of the crew does not show up for work. We have been told if we can give them workers with the basic skills and a good work ethics, they will hire them.



Passing all eight modules guarantees a student with an interview for a union apprenticeship position.

The Construction Industry is in need of trained workers to fill positions nationwide.
